You can't use the 'head for radio' joke anymore. Thanks to live streaming, social media and YouTube, radio is now a visual medium.

Leading the visual charge, the KIIS FM breakfast and morning shows studio in Melbourne has been utterly transformed with the installation of two video walls comprised of Philips commercial screens.

TRANSFORMATION

Prior to the refit of the ARN-owned studio, the KIIS FM breakfast show packages were grainy, poorly lit and generally underwhelming — something they're quick to admit.

Central to the refit strategy was to replace the worn out, wall-mounted domestic panels in the studio with a larger, wall-to-wall installation of commercial-grade panels that would display the show's branding. When ARN contacted video wall specialists, Current Projects, it knew their vision for the displays would be a significant investment, but were pleasantly surprised.

PRICE IS RIGHT

ARN Broadcast Engineer, Nick Payne, picks up the story: "We contacted Current Projects actually asking for another brand of commercial display, but Ewa [Zwarenkant] and the team there pointed us in the direction of Philips and we got an incredibly good price in comparison."

The Philips BDL5588XH 55-inch panels look stunning. They may only be running at some 15% brightness (so as to not compete with the studio lighting in the video packages) but virtually

every camera angle now has larger-than-life KIIS branding as its backdrop.

LOW REFLECTION

One key factor in the purchasing decision was the Philips screens' low surface reflection. When you have nine 55-inch panels in a small studio, it's crucial for the clarity of the video for the screens' 'Haze' value to be high.

Finally, ARN wasn't interested in using the screens to achieve any picture-in-picture or other video wall features, the screens needed to be easy to maintain and update. Nick Payne explains: "We're radio people, not vision people. We didn't want a media server running the displays, we wanted it to be really easy to use. As it stands we feed the 3x2 video wall with a 4K signal and its automatically split out to the six screens. The branding changes from show to show, but we won't use it to display video or the grand final."

HIDE IT FROM KYLE!

Only weeks after its installation, already the displays are having a serious impact. The video packages look stunning; the KIIS talent love the look; and management know they're on to something. "The talent have really fed off the new look, it's elevated the shows to a new level. We had the national program manager here recently," recalls Nick Payne. "After seeing the new studio with the Philips video walls he said 'we've got to hide this from Kyle [Sandilands]!' That's going to be next: putting this setup into our Sydney studio."

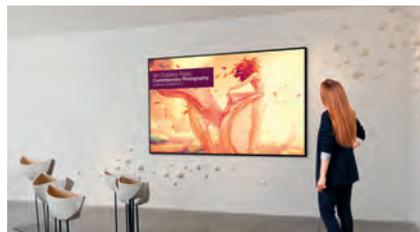

There are some 100 Noodle Box and Wokinabox quick service restaurants across Australia. Each is to receive an impressive digital upgrade. As a franchise, a restaurant undergoes a mandatory five-yearly refresh, and in this round digital menuboards will provide a new customer focus.

The new digital menuboards display the standard menu but can also provide local area marketing and a place to advertise a local menu addition. Moreover, Schweppes is on board, contributing to the cost of the rollout in exchange for marketing of its beverage offering.

The typical retail configuration sees four Philips D Line commercial panels arrayed in the 'canopy' area above the counter where customers place their order. The entire digital menuboard network is managed by the Fusion Signage CMS.

Stephen Russell is AR Concepts National Project Manager, charged with the responsibility of the nationwide rollout.

"I've had plenty of experience with Philips," commented Stephen Russell. "I recently specified D Line and, prior to that, the Q Series of Philips commercial displays in a 500-screen digital menuboard rollout for a US pizza delivery chain. The D Line has always been a reliable and a solid performer.

"I hadn't worked with the Fusion Signage CMS until I joined AR Concepts. It was already being implemented and our graphic designer reported he was very happy with it — it does what we need it to do in a QSR environment.

CASE STUDY: MONDOPAD TICKS ALL THE BOXES

The conferencing, meeting and collaboration capabilities of a public sector entity have been given a significant shot in the arm thanks to a new boardroom, featuring two InFocus Mondopads. Tasked with creating a large interactive meeting space, the Infrastructure Manager seized the opportunity to turbocharge the organisation's capabilities after an enforced move from one level to another within the building.

Previously the organisation had a small video conferencing space but nothing that gave them the capability needed to engage in interactive training (on site and remote). In fact, team members would sometimes need to hire a video conferencing space off site, which wasn't great for operational efficiency or the bottom line.

Having additional space as part of the relocation, the organisation was keen to invest in creating new meeting spaces, and in particular, having a multipurpose boardroom/meeting/training room as the jewel in the crown.

The Infrastructure Manager explains some of the demands placed on the new space:

"Our services and products are always being updated and these changes need to be conveyed to stakeholders across the state. Traditionally, we

undertake 'road shows', travelling across various regions state-wide conducting presentations. While this won't change immediately, having the ability to now also conduct interactive training with the MondoPads is a real advantage, and we anticipate significant cost and time saving as we continue to extend use of the platform."

TWO IN ONE

The Mondopad has its own wifi access point, allowing participants in the room to share content wirelessly and for guests to share their device's content without the need to log-in to the department's wifi network (a security advantage).

The organisation is a long-time Polycom client, and is able to leverage a network of hundreds of nodes throughout the state. The Mondopad has its own advanced VC capabilities but in this case has been set up to integrate with the Polycom codecs.

Once remote participants have joined the meeting, those in the room can use the Mondopad to run the presentation. On-screen annotations can be made and, in fact, the presenter's laptop can be controlled (reverse connectivity) via the Mondopad during the presentation wirelessly – a key selling point for this project.

With the growth in inner city living comes the need for inner city education.

Back in 2013 Haileybury College purchased a hi-rise city building opposite Flagstaff Gardens in the Melbourne CBD. The aim: to provide a primo education option, pre-school to Year 12, for inner-city dwellers and international students.

In 2014 Haileybury established an early learning centre on the ground floor. This was followed by junior school spaces ready for the 2016 academic year. In 2016, three levels of middle school classes came together along with the boardroom level on the top floor.

TECH: ALL CLASS

It's not every day that a big school embarks on such a large project involving so much AV and IT. As manager of all of Haileybury's AV and IT, Dale Eaton rode shotgun from the get-go. It was clear he was looking to standardise his equipment spec and have a sense of what tech a classroom would include for the next five years or more.

"It was about minimising variation," Dale summarises. "We standardised a lot of the rooms with the AV kit to make it easier. Across the four campuses we have more than 600 teaching spaces to look after. So when they were all so varied, it was a serious problem. We're now working towards standardising each campus as we go through an annual rolling refresh program."

PROJECTION OR LCD?

Projection or LCD screen? What was to be the principal classroom presentation tech? It occupied the brains of Dale Eaton and his team more than most decisions.

Dale Eaton: In discussions three years ago there was a lot of talk about putting panels up everywhere. During our research, we discovered that Epson was bringing out the EB595 ultra short-throw projector which gave us the interactivity we

were after. We felt that was the right combination – mature, proven technology, in the Epson projection; and the very latest interactivity.

We've immediately seen the benefits in classes such as those in the music department – writing musical notes on the board, then routing it straight back to the computer to be saved. From there the teacher can pop the next lesson up on the board and they're building a valuable stockpile of materials and resources as they go.

The Epson 595 projectors has taken us way beyond simply projecting onto a screen. The students coming through from junior school are accustomed to interactivity, and that interactivity brings educational advantages.

How important is it to the school to be perceived as a technological innovator?

Dale Eaton: It's one of the main goals of the school. We want to be on the cutting edge of technology but we're also happy to take our turn – we have no desire to be on the bleeding edge – it's worth learning from other people's mistakes and successes, and roll that into something we can develop and deploy ourselves.

We're constantly appraising new product, the fully-interactive touch panels, presentation recording products and the like. But testing and appraising is different to installing into a classroom.

COOKIE CUTTING EDGE

Now that the classroom AV spec has been agreed on, adding classrooms is administratively a smooth process as well as taking the headache out of the design process. Working with long-term electrical and AV contractor, Macmor, and relying on product such as the Epson EB595Wi, the rolling out of new spaces could hardly be easier.

Dale Eaton: It's a case of: here's a new room, raise a purchase order and say 'go make it look the rest of them'. It's all about removing variation. It really is.

CASE STUDY: LED DEPARTURES



It can be tough to stand out from the crowd. In the halls of Sydney Airport's International Departures, retailing is taken to another level. Digital signage plays a key role in attracting attention. So much so, in fact, that 'ordinary' LCD and video walls can sometimes lack the impact you might regularly expect.

Heinemann Duty Free, was well aware of this trap. It wanted something high-impact and something that would clearly differentiate its offering.

Heinemann approached Avico Electronics with an interesting brief: a four-faceted LED 'cube' for its flagship duty free store at Sydney Airport International terminal.

The cube needed to have 'seamless' corner joins. The cube would be taller than it would be wide (approx. 900mm wide by 1200mm high) to effectively 'box' a large structural column. The installation would need to look superb and attract top-end advertising clients, such as luxe liquor suppliers.

Avico spec'ed Aurora LED for the project. The Aurora LED tiles are fine pixel pitch (P1.8), providing all the resolution needed to display the high-end content. The display uses Qbic media players and a Smartsign CMS.

Avico took the inevitable Sydney Airport security restrictions in its stride – working over three nights, after hours.

The resulting installation is eye popping. With a 1500 nits capacity, the screen has all the brightness needed (and more) to attract attention. More

than that, the fine pixel-pitch resolution and superior colour rendition has instantly attracted high-end advertisers who guard their image (and the integrity of their trademark brand colours) extremely fiercely.

The innovative four-faceted LED augments an existing 8m x 4m Aurora LED display. The hi-def P3.9mm indoor SMD screen packs 3000-nit brightness capacity, is front serviceable, and features 16-bit greyscale, and 1/8-second scan rate performance. Behind the scenes is Novastar control gear (2 x VX4 processors) and Crestron control, which takes care of temperature and brightness sensing along with event triggering.

This was not a job to be trusted with a generic LED supplier. Aurora's quality assurance promise and renowned service and support means Heinemann Duty Free will enjoy the benefits of its distinctive display for years to come with zero down time.
